Level of Intrusion

Low concern

Response within 5 working days. Follow standard procedures and continue with only passive monitoring of the behaviour. There is no need for further evaluation unless subsequent behaviour changes in character and/or frequency, or identified protective factors are removed.

Moderate concern

Response within 3 working days. Develop and implement management following consult with threat assessment and management team.

High concern

Response within 48 hours. High priority escalation to threat assessment and management team. Commence safety planning for target(s).

Highest concern

Immediate escalation to critical incident management team and/or emergency services notification. Consider external threat consultant review.

Aggression Thermometer

How would you describe the Person of Concern's problem behaviour?

- Dysregulated No aggression. May be awkward, odd, bizarre, pressured, anxious, pleading.
- □ Significantly dysregulated Rude, excessively sarcastic, rigid, or refuse to engage or comply with staff.
- Distressed Low level anger, resentment, mistrust, or fear.
- □ Significantly distressed Paranoia, hypervigiliance, passive-aggressive, or self-depreciative without threats.
- Disruptive Intimidation, indirect threats to harm self or others, unwanted contact, misuse of processes, harassment.
- □ Significantly disruptive Fear-inducing intimidation, psychological pressure, unreasonable complaining, threats of harm to self or others.
- □ Dangerous Sexual harm, explicit threats of violence, attempted violence, persistent and resistant to interventions.
- □ Significantly dangerous Physical or sexual violence.

Intrusion Thermometer

How **frequent** is the behaviour happening?

- □ Once

How **<u>disruptive</u>** is the behaviour?

- □ Affects a single target in their work/study role and does not disturb business/ teaching operations.
